Statement of significance	Criterion a) 8 Edgeware Street is one of only 3 or 4 remaining Victorian era homes from the initial subdivision of the Church and School Lands at prospect to form the Winter Estate, bounded by Blacktown Road, Prospect Highway, and the Great Western Highway. These houses have survived the substantial redevelopment of the area by the First Homeworld village in the 1980's. 8 Edgeware Street and 29 Old Church Lane are the most intact of this group and the most viable for protection. These homes indicate the previous era of suburban / small farm development of the Prospect. Criterion c) The Cottage at 8 Edgeware Street is a typical Victorian four roomed brick cottage, cottage.

	HISTORY
Historical notes	The land on which 8 Edgeware Street is situated was originally identified as Church and School Lands (pre 1860 Parish Maps). The area was identified for subdivision in conjunction with the arrival of the railway to Blacktown in 1860.
	Between 1860 and 1887 the land was identified as Winters Estate a new subdivision DP 1645.
	By 1887 the Municipality of Prospect had been proclaimed and Winters land had been further subdivided. The land on which Edgeware Street, Algate Street and Old Church Lane are situated remained within two holdings retained by Peter Winter.
	By 1894 the streets had been formed. It is likely that the Victorian ere houses in the area were built around this time.
