Significance

Statement Of Significance

Attractively sited on the crest of the eastern embankment of the Nepean River and set back from Castlereagh Road, the farmhouse demonstrates the continued tradition of a rural economy in the locality. The cottage is a fine example of a large early twentieth century single storey weatherboard farmhouse nestled within a mature garden setting including Palms, Pines and Eucalypts. The intact planting scheme to the residence adds to the total concept of a Federation garden design.

Criteria a)

Historical Significance

The farmhouse and its small rural landholding demonstrate the predominantly rural economy of the area over generations based on the fertile soils of the river plain. The pattern of this rural economy is now characterised by a high number of small farm allotments and with a small number of residences.

The cottage is an example of a large early twentieth century farmhouse nestled within a mature garden setting including Pines and Eucalypts.

Physical Description

This attractive early twentieth century weatherboard cottage has a distinctive gambrel roof which continues over a return verandah and includes a painted chimney with terracotta pots. The verandah is partially enclosed with timber framed glazing and sunhood to the side. The symmetrical front elevation has a projecting porch with gabled roof. The verandah has timber square posts on brick balustrade. The centrally located timber panelled door is flanked with high level sidelights.

The house and immediate garden setting is delineated by a painted picket fence and includes low level shrubs and gardens with a prominent medium size palm to the right of the house. Just out of the fence are mature stands of trees including Pine and Eucalyptus trees that nestle the home within its setting. The house is surrounded by paddocks that are fenced off with either timber painted post and rail or mesh and metal fencing contributing to the rural nature of the property. A two car garage recently constructed with gable roof complements the existing character of the house.
